Discussion Questions

1. Has justice today become disconnected from God's justice? If so, how?
2. Consider the following occupations – plumber, doctor, journalist, minister/pastor, politician, lawyer and teacher – which are the most/least suitable/worthwhile for a Christian to undertake?

Read Colossians 3:23-24 (please pay particular attention to the *first* word of v.23). Are we guilty of endorsing the 'sacred-secular divide'? If so, how? For more info. about the sacred-secular divide, please use this link: <http://www.licc.org.uk/imagine/files/The%20Great%20Divide.pdf>.

3. Read Exodus 6:5-8, Deuteronomy 4:5-8 and Amos 5:15, 24. What do these verses teach us about God's character, His heart for justice?
4. Read 1 Peter 3:18 and John 3:16-17. What does the cross teach us about the nature and character of God's justice?
5. Read Micah 6:8. How can we – Christian law students and lawyers – live out these verses in our studies and/or practice as lawyers? What does it mean to love mercy? What does it mean to walk humbly with God?
